▲ The government of Cuba was overthrown by former president Fulgencio Batista. He ruled as a dictator until he too was ousted by the Castro revolution of 1959

**2000:** The Dot-com bubble reached its peak with the NASDAQ index reaching 5,048.62

**2006:** NASA's Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter entered orbit around the red planet after a seven-month journey

**2010:** Carlos Slim, Mexican billionaire and telecommunications magnate, became the world's richest person

**2017:** President Park Geun-hye of South Korea was forced from office over a corruption scandal
