March 19, 1932

▲ **Australia's iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge officially opened. It is the world's tallest steel arch bridge, rising 134m (440ft) above water level at its highest point**

1962: Bob Dylan's debut album, Bob Dylan, was released by Columbia

1982: The Argentine flag was raised on the island of South Georgia, precipitating the Falklands conflict

2002: Zimbabwe was suspended from the Commonwealth after Robert Mugabe's dubious election victory

2007: The Marshall Islands declared a state of emergency and sent ships to supply drinking water to outlying islands due to a prolonged drought
