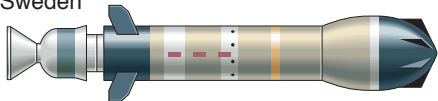

Sweden:
5,000 anti-tank rockets, field rations, body armour



U.S.: Additional \$350m – including **Javelin** anti-tank missiles – takes total commitment to \$1bn over past year

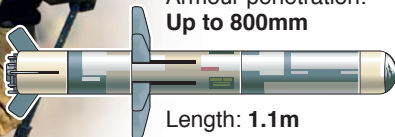


Disposable launcher
