Alexei Mordashov **\$29.1 billion**

Steel magnate on EU sanctions list. **Lady M** yacht, valued at \$72m, seized by Italian authorities



Vladimir Potanin **\$22 billion**

CEO of **Norilsk Nickel** metals and mining company. His \$300m **Nirvana** superyacht is in Maldives



Alisher Usmanov **\$16.2 billion**

Metals and telecoms tycoon. \$19m Sardinian villa seized and \$600m yacht blocked from leaving Hamburg



Gennady Timchenko **\$15.2 billion**

Chairman of Russian national hockey league sanctioned by U.S. and EU. \$55m yacht **Lena** seized in Italy



Roman Abramovich **\$12.3 billion**

Sanctioned by UK. Sale of **Chelsea FC** halted. Bought 15-bedroom London mansion for \$119m in 2011



Oleg Deripaska **\$2.5 billion**

Founder of aluminium giant **Rusal** sanctioned by U.S. and UK. Owns properties in New York and London



Eugene Shvidler **\$1.7 billion**

Business associate of Roman Abramovich. UK impounded private jet linked to Shvidler at Farnborough airport



Igor Sechin **\$169 million**

CEO of **Rosneft** sanctioned by U.S., EU and UK. **Amore Vero** yacht worth \$120m seized in France



Vladimir Soloviev **\$21 million**

Pro-Putin Russian TV host sanctioned by EU. Two properties worth \$8.8 million seized by Italian authorities
