▲ **The first successful non-direct blood transfusion, using stored blood rather than transfusing directly from donor to receiver, was performed**

1992: Greenpeace activists tried to penetrate the French nuclear test site at Mururoa Atoll

2000: Vladimir Putin won a decisive presidential election victory to become Russia's head of state

2007: Taiwan unveiled the Hsung Ying fighter aircraft, an upgraded version of their Ching-kuo plane
