▲ **Peru's famous archaeological site, Machu Picchu, reopened two months after torrential rain and landslides cut rail access and left some 4,000 tourists trapped**

2003: A housing complex in Hong Kong was evacuated when over 200 people developed the respiratory illness SARS

2012: Aung San Suu Kyi, released from house arrest after 20 years, won a seat in Myanmar's parliament

2014: Residents with homes near the Fukushima nuclear plant returned for the first time since the 2011 tsunami

2016: An extensive coral reef system was discovered off the coast of French Guiana and northern Brazil
