▲ Irish jockey Rachael Blackmore became the first woman to win the Grand National steeplechase, one of the world's oldest and most famous horse races

1912: The ill-fated Titanic sailed from Southampton on her maiden voyage

1972: Fifty countries agreed to ban the development, production and stockpiling of biological weapons

2002: An official report blamed the Dutch government and the UN for failing to prevent the Srebrenica massacre in Bosnia in 1995
