▲ The original Apple computer (later known as the Apple I), created by Steve Wozniak and Steve Jobs, was released at an introductory price of \$666.66

1982: British explorer Ranulph Fiennes completed the first pole to pole circumnavigation of the globe

2001: The Netherlands became the first country to give terminally ill patients the right to end their lives

2005: India and China signed an agreement resolving the 3,540km border between their vast nations

2019: President Omar al-Bashir of Sudan was deposed in a coup after nearly 30 years in office
