▲ **Candy Crush Saga**, a mobile puzzle video game variant of the browser game Candy Crush, was released. By 2017 it had received over 2.7 billion downloads

1557: The historic city of Cuenca, in the highlands of Ecuador, was founded by Spanish explorers

1992: The \$4 billion theme park Euro Disney opened near Paris. It was renamed Disneyland Paris in 1995

1994: Two lawyers posted the first example of commercial mass spam, targeting 5,500 net discussion groups

2010: The deepest ever undersea volcanic vents, or “black smokers”, were discovered in the Caribbean
