▲ **Marvel Comics published the first issue of The Incredible Hulk, a green-skinned, heavily muscled humanoid and his alter ego, a socially withdrawn physicist**

1869: The completion of the U.S. Pacific Railroad in Utah revolutionised the economy of the American West

1941: Hitler's deputy Rudolf Hess parachuted into Scotland in a bizarre attempt to negotiate a peace deal

1954: The silicon-based junction transistor, soon to be incorporated into the first transistor radio, went into commercial production

1994: Nelson Mandela was sworn in as South Africa's first black president
