UEFA Champions League

Man City, Liverpool and Chelsea qualified for group stage 2022-23. **Tottenham** will take final berth – ahead of rivals **Arsenal** – if they avoid defeat to Norwich

UEFA Europa League

Man Utd and West Ham both guaranteed European football next season – *Man Utd* hold advantage for Europa League berth, and will qualify with victory at Crystal Palace
