▲ U.S. singer and actress Judy Garland was born as Frances Gumm. She shot to fame in 1939 for her Oscar-winning role as Dorothy in *The Wizard of Oz*

1926: Innovative Catalan architect Antonio Gaudi died in Barcelona after being knocked down by a tram

1967: The Six-Day War ended with Israel capturing East Jerusalem, the West Bank, Gaza Strip and the Sinai

2002: India lifted a ban on Pakistani aircraft overflying its territory, easing tensions between the two nations

2002: Microelectrodes inserted into the arm enabled direct electronic communications between two humans
