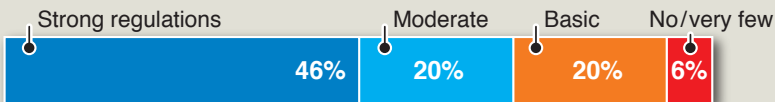


# Americans favour changing gun laws

A Reuters/Ipsos poll in the wake of the latest U.S. mass shooting finds that Americans support regulations of gun ownership, but do not have much optimism that politicians will respond



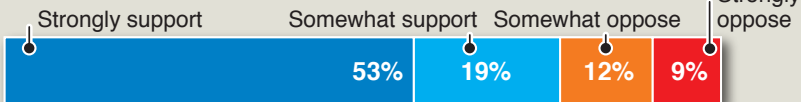
## Support strong or moderate regulations of gun ownership



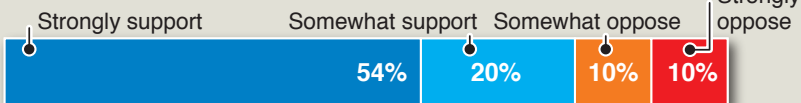
## Support “red flag” laws. Allowing police to confiscate firearms from people that courts say are dangerous
