Temporary exemption from EU ban

EU proposing complete ban in 6-8 months – covers more than two-thirds of imports

Germany, Poland pledge to halt imports by end of 2022

Total effect of EU action: Russian crude oil sales to EU could be reduced by 90 percent by end of 2022
