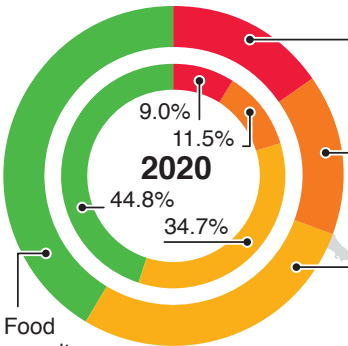


33 million facing hunger in Brazil

A national survey has found the number of people living in hunger in Brazil surged 73% in less than two years,

from 19.1m to 33.1m

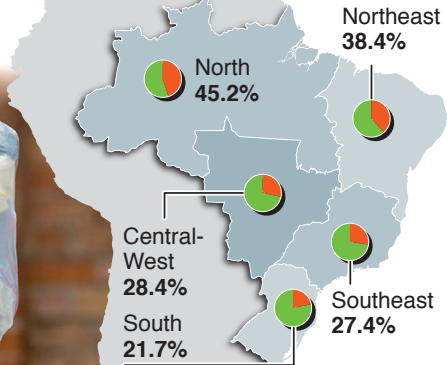
