

U.S. plan to increase Ukraine grain exports

The U.S. is working on a plan to build temporary silos along Ukraine's borders in a bid to export more than 20 million tonnes of grain by rail and address a growing global food crisis

1 Poland: Ukrainian rail system operates on different gauge, so grain must be transferred to different trains at border, where there are not many storage facilities

2 Romania: Involves transport by rail to ports on Danube river and loading cargoes onto barges for sailing to Constanta – complex and costly process

3 Black Sea: Ukraine and Russia have laid sea mines, trapping dozens of foreign ships in Ukrainian ports – many with grain cargoes onboard
