▲ **Swiss tennis star Martina Hingis, 16, won the ladies' singles championship at Wimbledon, becoming the youngest player to claim the title since 1887**

1977: In Pakistan, General Muhammad Zia-ul-Haq overthrew the government of Zulfikar Ali Bhutto

2002: The White Mosque reopened in Srebrenica in Bosnia, replacing the one destroyed in the 1992-95 war

2007: Scientists announced the discovery off Hawaii of a possible new species of cephalopod

2012: The Shard was inaugurated in London. At 310m (1,020ft) it is the tallest building in western Europe
