The UK is the fifth-largest global economy, but the increase in disposable income since before the financial crisis remains among the lowest in Europe, the Resolution Foundation finds

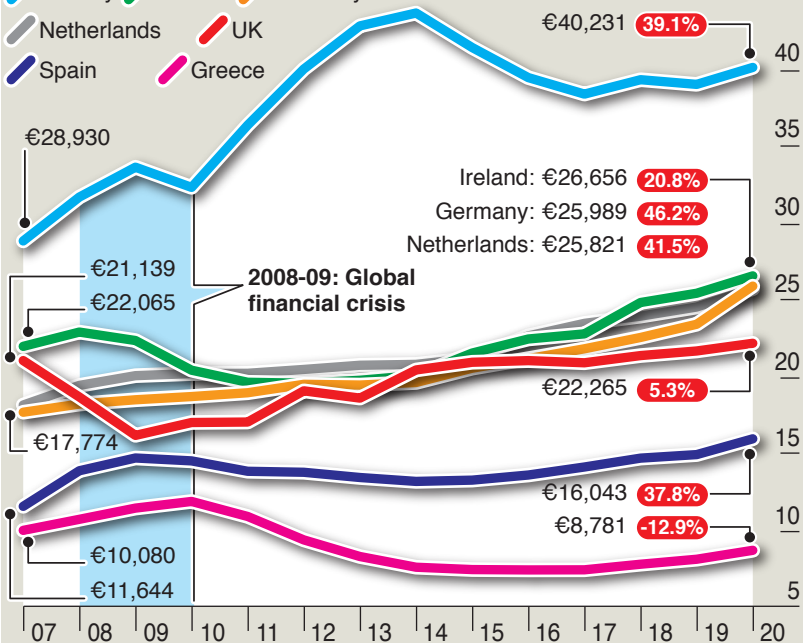
