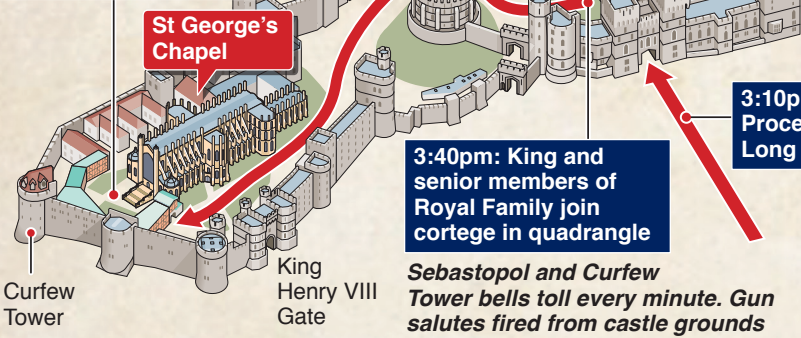


Queen Elizabeth II laid to rest



WINDSOR CASTLE

4:00pm: Coffin enters St George's Chapel for committal service



KING GEORGE VI MEMORIAL CHAPEL

Small chapel with its own vault, added in 1969. First structural addition to exterior of St George's Chapel since 1528



King George VI
Dec 14, 1895 – Feb 6, 1952
Early death at age 56 made Elizabeth Queen



Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother
Aug 4, 1900 – Mar 30, 2002
Died at age 101



Princess Margaret
Aug 21, 1930 – Feb 9, 2002
Ashes interred in chapel



Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh
Jun 10, 1921 – Apr 9, 2021

Following the funeral service at Westminster Abbey, the Queen will be laid to rest at St George's Chapel, Windsor, close to her parents, sister and husband

ST GEORGE'S CHAPEL

Fine example of Gothic architecture in England. Construction begun by **Edward IV** in 1475 and completed by **Henry VIII** in 1528
Chapel is spiritual home of **Order of the Garter**, order of chivalry established by **Edward III** in 1348

3:10pm, local time: Procession up Long Walk begins

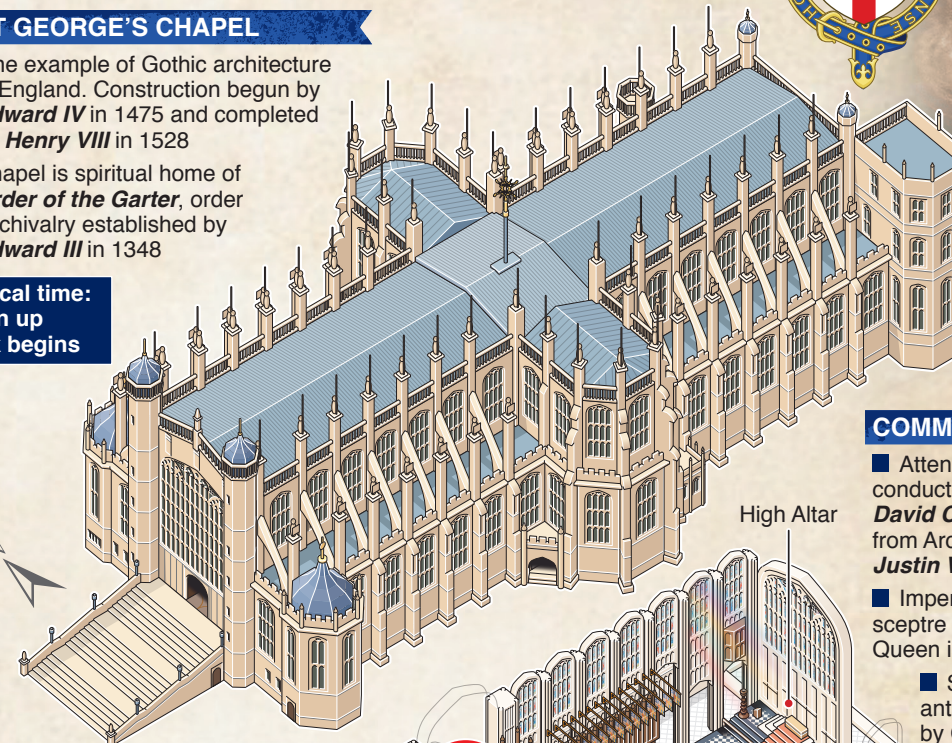
3:40pm: King and senior members of Royal Family join cortege in quadrangle

Sebastopol and Curfew Tower bells toll every minute. Gun salutes fired from castle grounds

Emblem of Order of the Garter

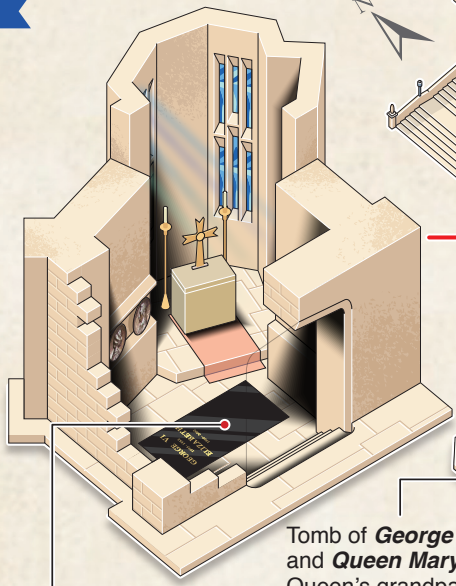


Queen Elizabeth II
Apr 21, 1926 – Sep 8, 2022



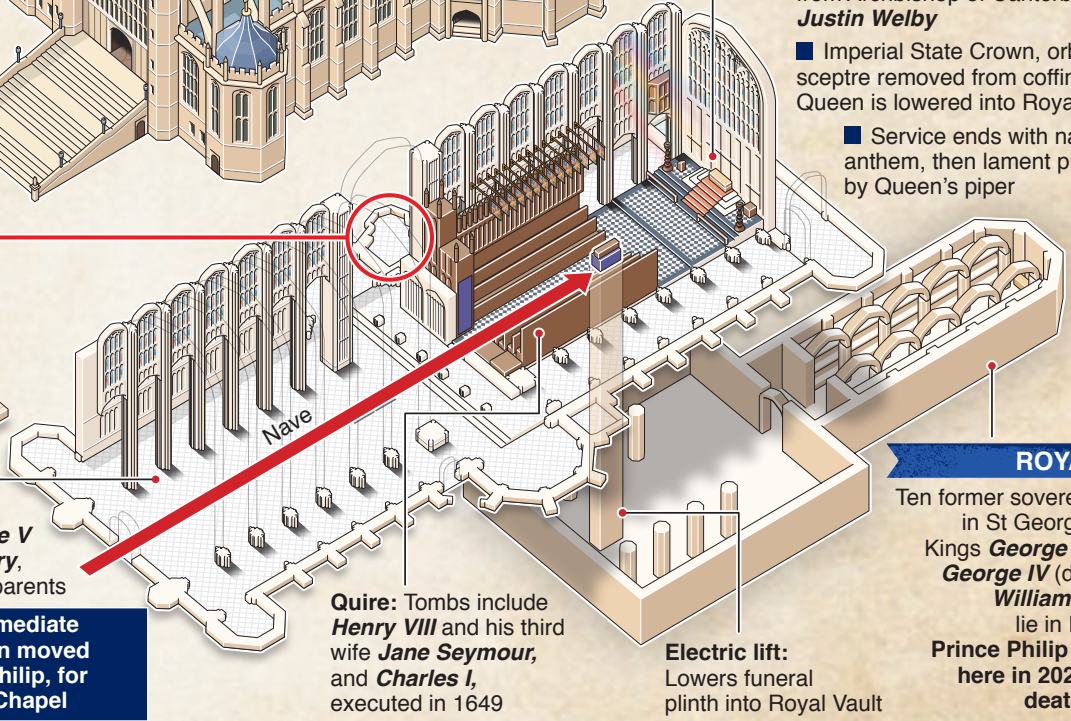
COMMITTAL SERVICE

- Attended by around 800 guests, conducted by Dean of Windsor **David Conner**, with blessing from Archbishop of Canterbury **Justin Welby**
- Imperial State Crown, orb and sceptre removed from coffin before Queen is lowered into Royal Vault
- Service ends with national anthem, then lament played by Queen's piper



Tomb of **George V** and **Queen Mary**, Queen's grandparents

7:30pm: Private service, attended by immediate members of Royal Family, will see Queen moved from Royal Vault, together with Prince Philip, for joint burial in King George VI Memorial Chapel



Quire: Tombs include **Henry VIII** and his third wife **Jane Seymour**, and **Charles I**, executed in 1649

Electric lift: Lowers funeral plinth into Royal Vault

ROYAL VAULT

Ten former sovereigns buried in St George's Chapel. Kings **George III** (d.1820), **George IV** (d.1830), and **William IV** (d.1837) lie in Royal Vault. **Prince Philip** laid to rest here in 2021, pending death of Queen
