▲ **William Caxton**, who introduced the printing press into England in 1476, is thought to have been born. He gained his knowledge of printing in Cologne and Bruges

1961: The border between East and West Berlin was closed ahead of construction of the Berlin Wall

1996: Data sent back by the Galileo space probe indicated there could be water on one of Jupiter's moons

2007: Satellite imagery revealed that Angkor, capital of the Khmer Empire from the 9th-15th centuries, covered around 3,000 square km

2020: Israel and the UAE agreed to establish diplomatic relations
