▲ **Charles Darrow, inventor of the board game Monopoly, died. Launched in 1935, the game's success made Darrow the first ever millionaire game designer**

1845: The first issue of the magazine Scientific American was published

1922: A New York radio station broadcast the first ever radio advertisement

1937: Toyota Motors, founded as a department of Toyota industries to create automobiles, became an independent company

1994: Russia withdrew the Soviet-era kopek, a coin worth 100th of a ruble, made worthless by inflation
