1950: Nino Farina won the first ever Formula One world championship at the Monza GP, driving an Alfa Romeo

1967: Sweden switched to driving on the right-hand side of the road

1992: Humanitarian flights to Sarajevo were suspended after an Italian cargo plane was shot down by a missile

2007: U.S. adventurer Steve Fossett went missing in Nevada after taking off in his single-engine aircraft. His body was discovered a year later
