

# Suu Kyi gets total of 20 years in prison

Myanmar's ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi has been sentenced to a further three years in prison for electoral fraud. She has now been sentenced to a total of 20 years, with eight more charges remaining



## **Dec 6, 2021: 2 years**

Convicted of inciting dissent against military and breaking public health Covid rules



## **Jan 10, 2022: 4 years**

Found guilty of having contraband walkie-talkies in her house and violating more Covid rules



## **Apr 27: 5 years**

Convicted of accepting bribes totalling \$600,000 and seven gold bars in 2017-18 from **Phyo Min Thein**, former chief minister of Yangon city and senior member of her **National League for Democracy (NLD)**



## **Aug 15: 6 years**

Found guilty of misusing funds from **Daw Khin Kyi Foundation** that Suu Kyi chaired, to build a home, and leasing government-owned land



## **Sep 2: 3 years**

Convicted of committing fraud in Nov 2020 general election, which NLD won overwhelmingly



***Nobel peace prize laureate denies all accusations. Trials have been condemned by rights groups as politically motivated***
