▲ British tennis player Emma Raducanu, aged 18, won the U.S. Open, becoming the first ever qualifier, male or female, to win a Grand Slam title

1952: The first artificial aortic valve, made of Flexiglas, was fitted into the heart of a 30-year-old patient

1962: The Beatles finished recording their first single, Love Me Do, at Abbey Road studios in London

2001: Three hijacked aircraft crashed into the twin towers of the World Trade Centre and the Pentagon

2012: The U.S. ambassador to Libya was killed in an attack on the U.S. consulate in Benghazi
