▲ **Europe's first moving walkway opened at Bank Underground station in London, six years after the first U.S. version was installed at a station in New Jersey**

1922: King Constantine of Greece abdicated following defeat in the Greco-Turkish War that followed WWI

2002: East Timor became the 191st country to join the United Nations

2002: A tract of Australian land used by Britain as a missile test range in the 1950s was returned to local Aborigines

2008: Zhai Zhigang carried out China's first spacewalk during the Shenzhou 7 mission. It lasted 22 minutes
