October 3, 1942

▲ **Germany's V2 rocket made its first successful test flight. It had a range of 200 miles and killed over 2,700 Londoners in the last months of World War II**

1932: Iraq became independent and joined the League of Nations

1952: Britain's first atomic bomb was detonated at the Monte Bello Islands off north-west Australia

1972: The Strategic Arms Limitation Treaty (SALT) limited the U.S. and Soviet Union to 200 anti-ballistic missiles each

2021: The Pandora Papers revealed how world leaders and other wealthy people hid property investments and other assets
