

U.S. Midterms: Key Senate battlegrounds

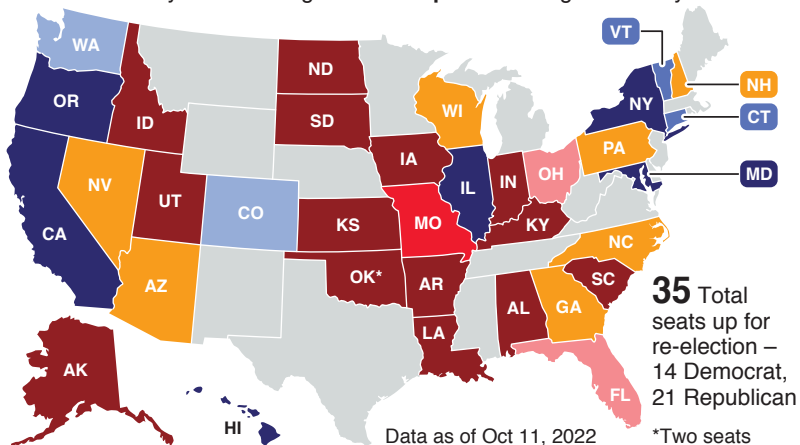
Republicans need to pick up only one seat to win control of the Senate in the U.S. midterm elections, which would allow them to block much of President Joe Biden's agenda

NEVADA: First Latina in U.S. Senate, **Catherine Cortez Masto**, trailing GOP nominee and former state attorney general **Adam Laxalt**



OHIO: Democrat **Tim Ryan** maintaining close race against **J.D. Vance** for open seat held by retiring Republican



PENNSYLVANIA: State lieutenant governor **John Fetterman** polling ahead of Republican **Mehmet Oz** in contest for open seat



WISCONSIN: State lieutenant governor **Mandela Barnes** looking to unseat Republican incumbent **Ron Johnson**
