

More Russians flee than join armed forces

More Russians have fled abroad than have joined the military since President Vladimir Putin announced a partial mobilisation to bolster his forces in Ukraine

EU: Almost **66,000**

Russians entered bloc in week to Sep 25, 2022, mostly through Finland

KAZAKHSTAN:

More than **200,000** Russian arrivals since Sep 21

KYRGYZSTAN:

Welcomed almost **30,000** Russians in six months leading up to mobilisation
