▲ Jubilant Berliners celebrated the fall of the Berlin Wall as the East German government threw open its border to West Berlin and West Germany

**1825:** A surveyor used limelight, intense white light got by heating lime, to continue working in misty weather

**1953:** Abdul Aziz ibn Saud, founder and first king of Saudi Arabia and father of six subsequent kings, died

**1967:** The first Saturn V rocket, carrying the unmanned Apollo 4 spacecraft, was successfully launched

**1967:** Rolling Stone magazine, the first national rock and roll periodical in the U.S., published its first issue
