▲ **Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon entered the tomb of the Egyptian pharaoh Tutankhamun, the first people to do so since it was sealed in 1337BC**

1922: American cartoonist Charles Schultz, creator of the Peanuts comic strip, was born

1942: The wartime movie **Casablanca**, one of the greatest films ever made, opened in New York

1992: South African president FW de Klerk outlined a timetable for democratic multi-racial elections

2021: **Omicron**, a new coronavirus variant first detected in South Africa, began spreading rapidly
