

Trump's picks fail to shine

Among more than 300 congressional and state-level endorsements backed by former U.S. President Donald Trump, just four won in midterm elections – others lost or remain tied



1 J.D. Vance: Venture capitalist and author won Senate seat for Ohio, defeating Democrat **Tim Ryan** by **53.3% to 46.7%**

3 Russell Fry: Ousted South Carolina's Republican Representative **Tom Rice**, who joined Democrats and handful of Republicans in vote to impeach Trump over deadly 2021 Capitol riot. Fry is ahead of Democrat **Daryl Scott** by **64.9% to 35.1%**

5 Mehmet Oz: Trump-backed celebrity doctor lost race for Pennsylvania Senate to Democrat **John Fetterman** **46.9% to 50.7%**

7 Kari Lake: Former TV news anchor is locked in Arizona governor's race with Democrat secretary of state **Katie Hobbs**

2 Ted Budd: Won Senate seat for North Carolina, narrowly defeating Democrat **Cheri Beasley** by **50.7% to 47.1%**

4 Harriet Hageman: Trump's House replacement in Wyoming for Republican **Liz Cheney**, who voted to impeach him for inciting Capitol riot. Hageman is leading Democrat **Lynnette Grey Bull** by **69.8% to 24.9%**

6 John Gibbs: Conspiracy theorist lost bid as Michigan Representative to Democrat **Hillary Scholten** **41.9% to 54.8%**

8 Kelly Tshibaka: Neck-and-neck in bid to defeat Alaska's incumbent Republican Senator **Lisa Murkowski**, who voted to impeach Trump
