▲ A school shooting in the U.S. killed 20 young children and six adults. In 2022 conspiracy theorist Alex Jones, who called it a hoax, was ordered to pay huge damages

1822: The Congress of Verona ended with Britain preventing a possible intervention in revolutionary Spain

1900: Max Planck's Quantum Theory, stating that radiant energy comes in small indivisible packets, was published

1939: The Soviet Union was expelled from the League of Nations for aggression against Finland

1962: The U.S. space probe Mariner II sent back the first close-up pictures of the planet Venus
