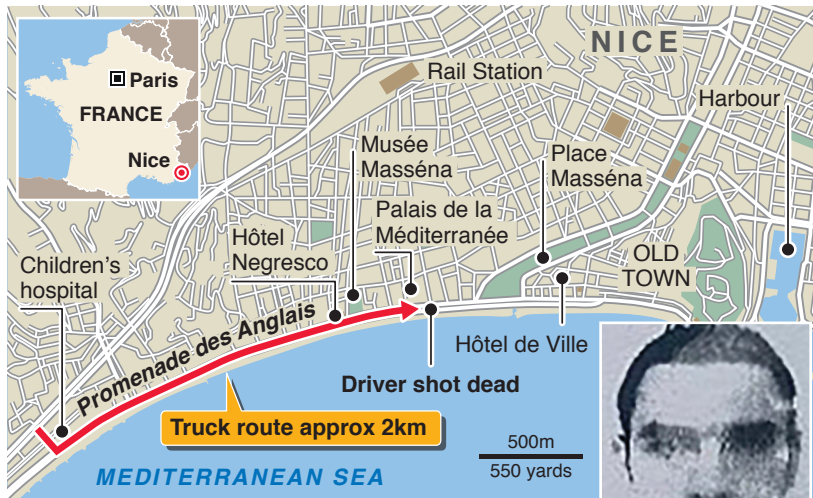


Eight found guilty over Nice truck attack

A French court has convicted all eight defendants in connection with the 2016 Bastille Day attack in Nice that killed 86 people

■ **Mohamed Ghraieb and Chokri Chafroud:** Tunisian nationals and friends of killer, convicted of terror charges and handed heaviest sentences of 18 years

■ **Ramzi Arefa:** Jailed for 12 years for supplying attacker with weapon while allegedly not knowing his terrorist intentions

■ **Other defendants:** Four Albanian nationals and one Tunisian given jail terms of two to eight years on charges of weapons trafficking or criminal conspiracy

■ **So-called Islamic State group** Claimed responsibility for attack but offered no proof that attacker had any direct contact with them
