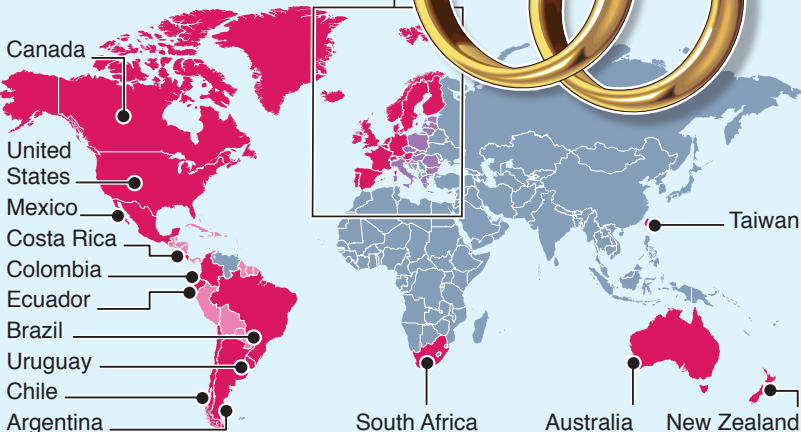


U.S. signs same sex marriage into federal law

A new law requires the U.S. federal government to recognise all marriages, including same-sex and interracial unions, preventing the conservative-led Supreme Court from overturning previous rulings
