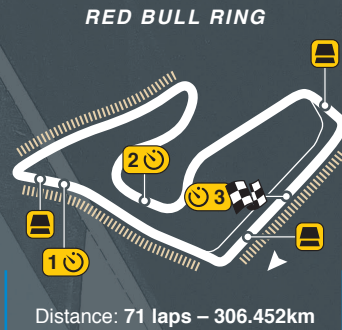


ROLL OF HONOUR: **Lewis Hamilton** (right), 6th in 2022, can still target eighth title for outright record. Only five drivers have won four or more championships

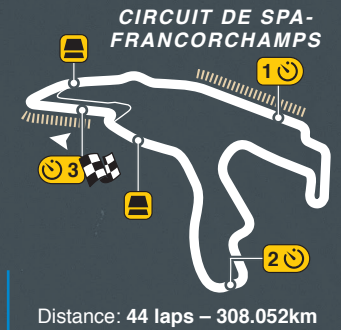

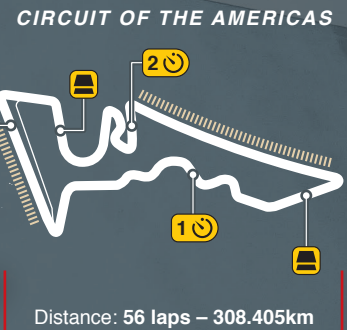

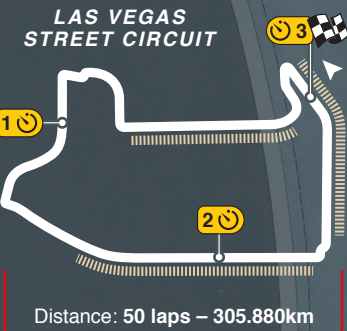
