White House records are supposed to go to the National Archives once an administration ends, so they can be stored securely

HOW MANY AND WHERE?

DONALD TRUMP

■ 10 documents dating to Biden vice-presidency found in private office at Washington think tank. “Small number” later found in garage at his Delaware home

■ 325 classified documents retrieved by National Archives from Trump’s Mar-a-Lago estate, including some turned over after subpoena, and others found in FBI search

WHAT DO CLASSIFIED FILES CONTAIN?

■ Papers reportedly include U.S. intelligence memos and briefing material related to Ukraine, Iran and UK

■ One set of papers reportedly marked “sensitive compartmented information” – similar to designation on some of Biden’s papers

IN WHICH CONDITION?

■ No allegation that Biden destroyed public records

■ Some documents reportedly destroyed or mutilated

HOW BIDEN, TRUMP RESPONDED

■ Biden team says it cooperated fully with investigation and returned documents as soon as they were discovered

■ Trump and aides have resisted National Archives’ repeated requests to return files, and failed to fully comply with subpoena
