▲ The Soviet airline Dobrolyot was founded, a date recognised as the beginning of civil aviation in the Soviet Union. It was renamed Aeroflot in 1932

1981: Gro Harlem Brundtland became Norway's first woman prime minister. She served three terms in office

1993: The Dutch parliament approved plans to allow euthanasia

2003: Legendary music producer Phil Spector was arrested for the murder of a woman shot dead at his home

2022: The leader of the Islamic State killed himself by triggering an IED during a raid by U.S. special forces in northwest Syria
