February 10, 1931

▲ The city of New Delhi was inaugurated as the capital of India. It houses all three branches – legislative, executive and judicial – of the Indian government

1942: Glenn Miller received the first ever gold disc for selling one million copies of Chattanooga Choo Choo

1962: Gary Powers, U.S. pilot shot down over the Soviet Union in 1960, was exchanged for KGB agent Rudolf Abel

2003: Scientists said they had discovered the first known asteroid with a solar orbit between Earth and the sun

2008: The 14th century Namdaemun Gate in Seoul was destroyed by fire
