

Coronation of King Charles III

The coronation celebrations will feature street parties, a concert at Windsor Castle, light shows and a public holiday where community volunteering will be encouraged

SAT, MAY 6, 2023

- Procession from **Buckingham Palace** to **Westminster Abbey**



- **Charles** is crowned King, and **Camilla** Queen Consort, in ceremony conducted by Archbishop of Canterbury, **Justin Welby**

- **Coronation Procession** returns to Buckingham Palace

- **King and Queen Consort** appear on palace balcony, accompanied by members of **Royal Family**



SUN, MAY 7

- **Coronation Big Lunch:** Street parties and local events



- **Coronation Concert** at **Windsor Castle**, featuring global music icons and **Coronation Choir** drawn from diverse community choirs and amateur singers

- *Several thousand concert tickets available via public ballot*

- **Lighting Up The Nation** will see iconic locations across UK lit up using projections, lasers and drone displays

MON, MAY 8

- **Big Help Out** – extra public holiday – aims to encourage community volunteering projects, in bid to create lasting legacy from coronation weekend
