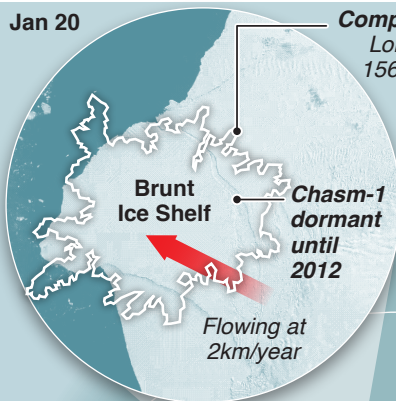


Antarctic iceberg the size of London

An iceberg the size of London has calved off the Antarctic continent after cracks extended across the Brunt Ice Shelf

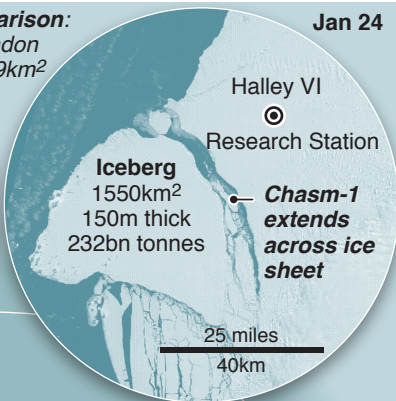
