February 15, 1903

▲ The teddy bear was introduced in the United States, named after President Theodore (Teddy) Roosevelt who had spared the life of a bear cub during a hunt

1993: Scientists announced the discovery of a huge range of volcanoes in deep waters in the South Pacific

2003: Millions worldwide marched against the planned war in Iraq

2013: A meteor exploded over Chelyabinsk, in Siberia, injuring more than 1000 people

2022: Intense rainfall triggered flash floods and mudslides in the Brazilian city of Petropolis, killing over 230 people
