

Sudan to normalise relations with Israel

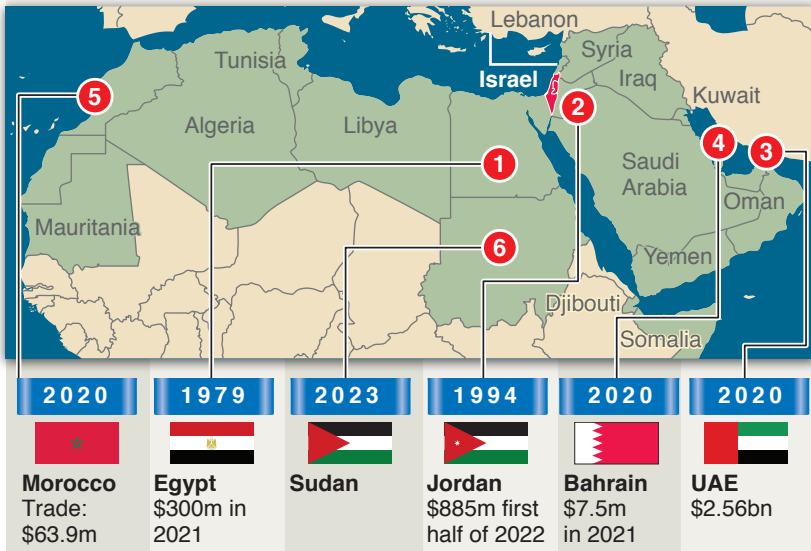
Khartoum is set to sign a formal peace deal with Israel in a highly symbolic move - the city was the venue for the 1967 Arab League declaration that denied recognition of the Jewish state


ISRAEL AND THE ARAB LEAGUE

1948	Arab League invades newly-formed State of Israel
1964	Formation of Palestine National Council and PLO
1967	Khartoum Resolution : "No peace with Israel, no recognition of Israel, no negotiations"

 **Palestinian Authority**: Peace deal in 1994, intermittent security and civil co-operation. Wars broke out in 2002, 2008, 2012, 2014
