▲ The tiny principality of Andorra adopted its first constitution, reducing the feudal powers of two co-princes, the President of France and Bishop of Urgell

1983: OPEC cut its official oil prices for the first time in its 22-year history, and introduced production quotas

2003: Turkish MPs approved Recep Tayyip Erdogan, chairman of the ruling party, to succeed as premier

2013: Xi Jinping formally became President of China, completing the transition of power

2013: Scientists confirmed that the new particle discovered in 2012 was the elusive Higgs boson
