▲ **Soviet cosmonaut Alexey Leonov became the first human to walk in space, making a 12-minute tethered spacewalk during the Voskhod 2 mission**

1923: Germany decreed butter could no longer be served in restaurants as the price had become so inflated

2003: British Prime Minister Tony Blair won parliamentary support to wage war on Iraq

2014: Russia formally annexed Crimea after a referendum. The West refused to recognise the vote

2022: The 1915 Çanakkale Bridge, the first bridge over the Dardanelles, was opened in Turkey
