**1 Mar, U.S.:** Australian premier **Anthony Albanese** is likely to visit Washington to unveil the design for a fleet of nuclear-powered submarines intended to counter China's growing naval might

**2 Mar 5, China:** **Xi Jinping** will formally be confirmed as president for a third term, and his hand-picked government team officially installed at the annual **National People's Congress**

**3 Mar 14, European Union:** A plan to overhaul the EU's power market, to make electricity prices less dependent on volatile fossil-fuel costs, is unveiled

**5 Mar 31, UK:** A life-size cast of a **Titanosaur**, the largest ever dinosaur, goes on show at London's **Natural History Museum**, the first such display in Europe

**6 Mar, Turkey:** **President Erdogan** has pledged to begin constructing almost 200,000 homes in earthquake-devastated areas, as he gears up for one of the toughest electoral races of his 20 years in power

**4 Mar 5, Estonia:** Prime Minister **Kaja Kallas**, who has taken a hawkish line against **Vladimir Putin**, is favoured to retain power as the Baltic nation goes to the polls

**7 Mar 4-5, U.S.:** Three dozen 166-year-old Cuban cigars will be a star attraction at an auction of historic California Gold Rush-era artifacts recovered from a ship that sank off the Carolina coast in 1857

**8 Mar 12, U.S.:** Sci-fi hit **Everything Everywhere All at Once**, Irish dark comedy **The Banshees of Inisherin**, and German WWI film **All Quiet on the Western Front**, are expected to dominate at the Oscars
