March 29, 1901

▲ **Daimler's Mercedes 35 HP, regarded as the first modern automobile, made its debut. It was named after the daughter of the man who commissioned it**

1891: Georges Seurat, French post-impressionist painter who developed Pointillism, died at age 31

1973: The last remaining U.S. combat troops withdrew from Vietnam

1993: Senior executives of Hoover were fired after vastly oversubscribed promotions involving free air travel cost the company over £20 million

1993: Clint Eastwood won Best Film and Best Director Oscars, the first of his career, for his film *Unforgiven*
