▲ The anti-impotence drug Viagra first went on sale in the United States. It was an instant success, with annual sales peaking in 2008 at \$1.934 billion

1998: A peace settlement was reached in Northern Ireland which became known as the Good Friday Agreement

2003: Air France and British Airways announced that Concorde was soon to be withdrawn from service

2003: Haiti recognised voodoo as a religion so marriages could be accepted as legal

2022: Imran Khan was ousted as Prime Minister of Pakistan in a motion of no-confidence
