

Putin accused of war crimes

The International Criminal Court's arrest warrant accuses Russian president Vladimir Putin of war crimes including the unlawful deportation of children to Russia from occupied areas of Ukraine

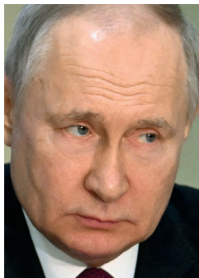

CHILDREN INVOLVED

■ Russia admits holding at least **1,400** Ukrainian "orphans", but says at least **2,000** children travelled to Ukraine unaccompanied

■ Ukraine puts number of children forcibly taken to Russia at **16,221**



■ Russia has held at least **6,000** Ukrainian children, and likely many more, in **43** camps in Russia and Crimea for purposes of political re-education, according to study by Yale University
