▲ **Emmanuel Macron became the first French president in 20 years to win a second term, clinching a bigger than expected victory over far right-winger Marine Le Pen**

1967: Vladimir Komarov was the first person to be killed in space when Soyuz 1 crashed back to Earth

2007: The composition of Jadarite was found to be similar to that of the fictional Superman's Kryptonite

2008: The U.S. accused North Korea of helping Syria rebuild a nuclear reactor at a site destroyed by Israel
