*April 27, 1828*

▲ The London Zoological Gardens in Regent's Park, the world's first scientific zoo, opened. Initially intended for scientific study, it opened to the public in 1847

**1978:** Afghanistan's President Daoud was killed by armed forces who then set up an Islamic government

**1993:** Eritrea gained independence from Ethiopia following 30 years of bitter civil war

**2018:** The leaders of North and South Korea, Kim Jong-un and Moon Jae-in, held a historic summit

**2022:** Russia's Gazprom suspended gas supplies to Poland and Bulgaria for not paying in roubles
